Different Types of Lulah and Shish Kabobs that Instantly Melt in Your Mouth

Skewers of kebabs (kabobs) over a simmering charcoal fire in a barbecue oven are a sight to behold, and the dominating spicy flavors soothe the senses. Beef Shish Kabob: This classic skewer-prepared meat dish is made by skewering minced or ground beef and grilling it over a slow charcoal fire till it turns brown. The beef sirloin is marinated with authentic Asian herbs and traditional spices from the Middle East. The base of the kebab is seasoned meat smoked for hours in a BBQ oven. It is served with Anaheim green chili pepper, Basmati rice, Armenian salad, and roasted tomatoes.

Chicken Lulah/Lule Kabob: This dish is prepared by skewering minced chicken, and grilling it perfectly for the right texture, softness, and color. You can also make it with lamb meat (mutton) and pork. The process of roasting and smoking the kebab is time-intensive, requiring a 5-step process. The meat is minced or cut into thin pieces, marinated, seasoned, and cooked thoroughly. It is seasoned with onions, parsley, salt, and black pepper, and served with Hummus, salad, and mashed potatoes.

Beef Lulah Kabob Wrap: If you love to munch on the go, this finger-licking meat kabob wrap is the right choice. It is made with ground-up beef sirloin, grilled on skewers, and seasoned/marinated with onion, coriander, and sumac. This is also referred to as a Persian mini kabob or a Lule kabob, which tastes best with a Georgian Shoti Puri flatbread.
